Description:	<p>The Chicago History Museum is proud to unveil its first-ever crowd sourced exhibition in a new café-style space designed for thoughtful listening, reading, and conversation.</p> <p>Chicago Authored is a multimedia-driven gallery experience that features a collection of diverse and inspiring works by writers, past and present. These authors define the character of Chicago and help us understand the complexity of our great city.</p> <p>Two new full-length mobile multimedia programs, <i>Chicago Authored</i> and <i>Crossroads Authored</i>, propel the experience. The exhibition and audio tour invite visitors to discover the works of Chicago writers that capture the city from four perspectives: a view from a window, through an open door, into a keyhole, and reflected in a mirror.</p>

Transportation: CTA buses 22, 36, 72, 73, 151, and 156 stop nearby. The Brown Line Sedgwick station and Red Line Clark/Division station are also located approximately one half-mile from the Museum.
